Description

The attached patch amends bin/cat/cat.c so the output is the same aside from blank lines being numbered or unnumbered, depending on whether cat was invoked with -ne or -be.

At present, when cat is invoked with -be, there is an additional difference that the '\$' on blank lines is placed on the far left of the output.

The patch originates from r1.17 of bin/cat/cat.c from NetBSD.
