Hi Kiril,

Do you have means to install DFBSD into another machine? That way you could build a new ISO image without 'device ohci' to see if that helps.

Another option would be to modify ISO image contents before writing it to CD, replacing the kernel in the ISO with a kernel without ohci. I can provide it if you are able to do the rest of the process.
